ORDINANCE NO. 0009

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR TWO-YEAR STAGGERED TERMS OF OFFICE FOR THE MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF INDIAN LAKE, TEXAS:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF INDIAN LAKE, TEXAS:

- Sec. 1 That the term of office for the Mayor and five (5) Aldermen of the Town of Indian Lake shall be two (2) years, and said terms of office will be staggered.
- Sec. 2 The Mayor and two (2) Aldermen, determined by lot at the first meeting of the Board of Aldermen following the next annual election after the adoption of this Ordinance shall serve two-year terms. The remaining Aldermen shall hold office for an initial term of one (1) year. Thereafter, all members of the Board of Aldermen hold office for terms of two (2) years and until their successors are qualified and acting.
- Sec. 3 This Ordinance shall be published and become effective when published in compliance with Art. 1152 V.T.C.S. as amended by Acts 1967, 60th Leg., p. 468, Ch. 2/7/8 1, emerg. eff. May 19, 1967.
