

ORDINANCE NO. 102

AN ORDINANCE SETTING FORTH THE REQUIREMENT OF DECALS TO BE DISPLAYED ON VEHICLES OWNED BY RESIDENTS AND PROPERTY OWNERS OF THE TOWN OF INDIAN LAKE FOR SECURITY PERPOSES.

WHEREAS: In order to prevent looting, theft, and other crimes from occurring during times of emergency evacuations like hurricanes the Town needs a way to allow entrance into the Town only by residents or property owners.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED THAT: All property owners and residents of the Town of Indian Lake, whether owning or renting property in the Town of Indian Lake be required to register their vehicles at the Town Hall and receive an Town of Indian Lake emergency decal for each of their vehicles. The decal must be displayed on the front driver side of the windshield. In cases of emergency evacuations the Town will be closed off at the entrances and only vehicles with the decal displayed on the windshield will be allowed entrance into the Town until the emergency evacuation has been lifted.
