


ORDINANCE NO. 0010

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE BURNING OF TRASH OR REFUSE:  
PROVIDING A PENALTY; AND AUTHORIZING PUBLICATION.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE  
TOWN OF INDIAN LAKE, TEXAS:

- Sec. 1. That the starting, causing, or allowing of the burning of any trash or refuse, or the burning of any materials of any nature are expressly forbidden within the Town of Indian Lake, Texas.
- Sec. 2. This prohibition does not include barbecue grills wherein persons are cooking around said grill in connection with a picnic and further providing that said fire is constantly supervised and properly extinguished and failure to properly extinguish said fire shall be deemed a violation of this ordinance.
- Sec. 3. This prohibition does not include a campfire which shall include all type barbecue and gas pits wherein persons are cooking around said fire or using the same in connection with a picnic, if said campfire is not within 200 feet of any type structure, and further providing that said campfire is constantly supervised, and the failure to properly extinguish said fire shall be deemed a violation of this ordinance.
- Sec. 4. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance, or shall fail to comply therewith or with any of the requirements thereof, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be liable to a fine, and upon conviction of any such violation shall be fined in any sum of not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00); and each day any such violation shall be permitted to exist shall constitute a separate and distinct offense.
- Sec. 5. This ordinance shall be published and become effective when published in compliance with Art. 1162 V.T.C.S. as amended by Acts 1967, 60th Leg., pg. 468, Ch.212, §1, Emerg. eff. May 19, 1967.
