

TOWN OF INDIAN LAKE  
CITY ORDINANCE NO 026

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Indian Lake that the discharge of firearms, or rifles, B.B. and Pellet guns, Bow and Arrows or any projectile throwing device within the City limits of Indian Lake shall be unlawful, provided however, it shall not be a violation of this statute if said firearm is discharged in connection with the preservation of life, or property, or in the line of duty by any peace officer. .

SECTION 111 ;

Any person in violation of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a fine of not more than \$50.00

SECTION 1V;

Should any part or provision of this ordinance be held invalid or illegal by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining portions thereof shall remain in full force and effect and to that extent shall be considered severable.

SECTION V:

This ordinance shall be published and become effective when published in compliance with Article 1152 V.T.C.S. as amended by Acts 1967, 60th Legislature, page 4 68, Chapter XII S1, emergency effective May 19 1967.
