ORDINANCE NO. 0006

AN ORDINANCE APPORTIONING CERTAIN OVERLAPPING AREAS OF THE EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF LOS FRESNOS AND THE TOWN OF INDIAN LAKE TO THE CITY OF LOS FRESNOS PURSUANT TO MUTUAL AGREEMENT OF THE RESPECTIVE GOVERNING BODIES OF SAID CITY AND TOWN

WHEREAS, the governing bodies of the City of Los Fresnos and the Town of Indian Lake have mutually agreed to the apportionment between said City and Town of overlapping areas of their respective extraterritorial jurisdiction, as hereinafter set out; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Los Fresnos has heretofore, on the 22nd day of February, 1979, duly adopted an Ordinance, pursuant to said Agreement, apportioning to the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the Town of Indian Lake, the area theretofore within the extraterritorial jurisdiction of said City lying West of FM 1575 and North of Whipple Road, such Ordinance to become effective when, pursuant to said Agreement, the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Indian Lake shall have duly adopted an Ordinance apportioning to the extraterritorial jurisdiction of said City the area presently within the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the Town of Indian Lake lying East of FM 1575 and South of Whipple Road; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEM OF THE TOWN OF INDIAN LAKE:

Section 1. THAT the area presently within the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the Town of Indian Lake lying East of FM 1575 and South of Whipple Road be, and the same is hereby apportioned to the City of Los Fresnos.

Section 2. THAT this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon being passed and approved.
