## ORDINANCE NO. 0064

AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING THE OFFICE OF TOWN MARSHALL AND PROVIDING THAT THE DUTIES OF SAID OFFICE SHALL NOW BE PERFORMED BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE OF THE TOWN OF INDIAN LAKE, TEXAS; AND REPEALING AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTY, SEVERABILITY AND AUTHORIZING PUBLICATION:

WHEREAS, the Town of Indian Lake did by Ordinance No. 0063 Create a Police Department for the town Of Indian Lake, Texas; and

WHEREAS, the office of Town Marshal is duplicitous of the duties and functions of the duties and functions of the Town's police department; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF INDIAN LAKE, TEXAS:

- Section 1: The office of Town Marshal is hereby abolished and the same shall be declared to no longer exist with the Town of Indian Lake, Texas.
- Section 2: All the duties, functions and powers of the Town Marshal are hereby conferred upon the Chief of Police of the Town of Indian Lake, Texas and all subordinate policemen thereunder as they may be directed by the Chief of Police.
- **Section 3:** Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance, or shall fail to comply therewith or with any of the requirements thereof, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be liable to fine and, upon conviction of any such violation, shall be fined in any sum of not more than One Hundred (\$100.00)Dollars for each offense, and each day that such violation exists shall be considered a separate offense.
- Section 4: Ordinance No. 0018-A which transferred the duty of Town Marshall to the Cameron County Sheriff's Department is hereby repealed in total.

Ordinance No. 0064 continued:

**Section 5:** Is any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision thereof, other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional.

**Section 6:** This Ordinance shall become effective when published or posted according to law.
