## ORDINANCE NO. 65

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE FISCAL YEAR OF THE TOWN OF INDIAN LAKE FROM JANUARY TO OCTOBER EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 1999.

It has been determined that it is in the best interest of the Town of Indian Lake to change its fiscal year to make it more compatable with the Town's tax year and other governmental agencies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF INDIAN LAKE, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the Town of Indian Lake, as of October 1, 1999, will use the twelve month period of October through September of each year, hereafter, as being the Town's fiscal year.

Section 2. Should any part or provision of this ordinance be held invalid or illegal by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining portions thereof shall remain in full force and effect and to that extent shall be considered severable.
