

ORDINANCE NO. 103

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE MAXIMUM WEIGHT OF A VEHICLE UTILIZING THE ROADS OF THE TOWN OF INDIAN LAKE TEXAS AND SETTING THE LENGTH OF CARGO VEHICLES THAT MUST BE ESCORTED INTO TOWN.

WHEREAS: In order to prevent damage to the roads in the Town of Indian Lake and damage caused by unescorted cargo vehicles to property belonging to the Town or to the Residence of the Town of Indian Lake there needs to be an ordinance setting the weight and lengths of the vehicles utilizing the roads of the Town of Indian Lake.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED THAT:

SECTION 1: No vehicle having a gross weight of 20,000 pounds (10 short tons) shall be permitted to utilize, use, or drive within the jurisdiction of the Town of Indian Lake, Texas with the exception of Henderson Road.

SECTION 2: No cargo vehicle beyond 56 feet in length shall be permitted to utilize, use, or drive within the jurisdiction of the Town of Indian Lake, Texas, with the exception of Henderson Road, without a police escort. Prior to entry into the Town of Indian Lake the Indian Lake Police Department must to be notified and an escort must to be scheduled.

SECTION 3: Variances of this Ordinance may be made by prior negotiations with the City Mayor or other designated representative.

SECTION 4: Persons violating this Ordinance will be held liable for a penalty fine up to \$500 for each violation.
