

ORDINANCE NO. 22

AN ORDINANCE SETTING FORTH THE USE OF GATES ON THE WEST ENTRANCES TO THE TOWN OF INDIAN LAKE FOR IMPLEMENTING SECURITY TO THE RESIDENTS, RENTERS AND PROPERTY OWNERS FOR ALL PROPERTY THEREIN.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Indian Lake that: for security reasons, the West entrance to the Town of Indian Lake being North and South from Henderson Road, be closed by gates from dusk to dawn daily.

Violation of this ordinance shall carry a fine of up to \$200.00 for opening or tampering with the gates erected by the Town of Indian Lake in accordance with this ordinance, plus, as an additional fine, the cost of repairing any damage by tampering with the gates.
