ORDINANCE NO. 46

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE CARE, MAINTENANCE AND DEVELOPMENT OF THE THREE ISLANDS OF INDIAN LAKE, TEXAS. THIS ORDINANCE SHALL PROVIDE FOR THE PROTECTION AND PRESERVATION OF THE WILDLIFE AND FLORA OF THESE ISLANDS: TO PROMOTE AND ADVANCE THE NATURAL BEAUTY AND PROVIDE A HABITAT FOR THE WILDLIFE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMAN OF THE TOWN OF INDIAN LAKE, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1. The Mayor shall appoint a committee to oversee the planting, development and care of the Islands. No persons will plant, move, change, cut, burn or in any way destroy the fauna of the Islands without permission of the Island Committee.

Section 2. Present foot bridges to the Islands are private property, therefore no unauthorized persons may use these bridges without prior permission of the owners.

Section 3. Children, under the age of 16 years, must be accompanied by their parents or guardian.

Section 4. No person shall destroy or mutilate any tree, plant or shrub, or disturb the nesting places of the birds, be they wild or domestic.

Section 5. No refuse shall be deposited or left on the Island or thrown into any section of the Lake.

Section 6. Any person in violation of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be liable to a fine of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and not more than Twenty Five (\$25.00) plus Court Costs.
