

ORDINANCE NO. 0005

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THAT THE TOWN OF INDIAN LAKE WILL AFFORD A LEGAL DEFENSE FOR ANY LAWSUIT FILED AGAINST ANY TOWN OFFICIAL OR BOARD OR OTHER OFFICIAL BODY OF THE TOWN OF INDIAN LAKE, TEXAS; AND AUTHORIZING PUBLICATION.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF INDIAN LAKE, TEXAS:

- Sec. 1. That the Town of Indian Lake will provide, at its expense, legal defense for any lawsuit filed against any official or official town board when said lawsuit is grounded or based on the discharge of their official duties in behalf of the town.
- Sec. 2. The Town of Indian Lake will indemnify, save and hold harmless any town official or official board when any judgment is rendered against the same when said judgment was based on said official or board discharging their official duties in behalf of the town.
- Sec. 3. Except, no defense or indemnity will be provided for any charges or allegations of an official or board for misconduct, bad faith, or other improper or illegal act; and, in such cases, said individual shall have to afford their own legal defense to said allegations.
- Sec. 4. Should any part or provision of this ordinance be held invalid or illegal by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining portions thereof shall remain in full force and effect and to that extent shall be considered severable.
- Sec. 5. This ordinance shall be published and become effective when published in compliance with Art. 1152 V.T.C.S. as amended by Acts 1967, 60th Leg., page 468, Ch 12 S 1. emerg. eff. May 19, 1967.
